AN ACT Relating to Stocking Certain Waters With Brown Trout.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 37, § 59-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 59-A, to read as follows :

‘Sec. 59-A. Stocking certain waters with brown trout regulated. It shall be unlawful to stock any lake, pond or stream with brown trout, except such lake, pond or stream known to contain only bass and pickerel.’
