COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 473, L.D. 666, Bill, "An Act Relating to Number of Councillors in Town of Fort Fairfield."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'An Act Relating to Number of Councillors and Members of Superintending School Committee in Town of Fort Fairfield.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill, in the 5th and 6th lines of that part designated "Sec. 2", by striking out the underlined words "the Revised Statutes of 1954 and amendments thereto" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'section 2-A'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the Referendum a new section 2, to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. P. & S.L., 1943, c. 5, §2-A, additional. Chapter 5 of the private and special laws of 1943, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Superintending school committee; election; salary. The superintending school committee shall be composed of 5 in number and shall be elected as follows:

At the next annual town meeting to be held in March, 1958, 2 members shall be elected for a term of 3 years, 2 members for a term of 2 years and one member for a term of one year; and thereafter the annual vacancies caused by the expiration of terms shall be filled for terms of 3 years. Vacancies due to death, resignation or other causes shall be filled for the unexpired term at the next annual town meeting or at a special town meeting called for that purpose.'"

Further amend said Bill by striking out the question in the Referendum and inserting in place thereof the following question: "Shall the Act Relating to Number of Councillors and Members of Superintending School Committee in Town of Fort Fairfield, passed by the 98th Legislature, be accepted?"
