AN ACT Relating to Merchandise Maintained by Retail Store Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 32, amended. The 1st sentence of the last paragraph of section 32 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 10 of chapter 355 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘All retail store licensees must have and maintain an adequate stock of merchandise reasonably compatible with a stock of liquor in no case less than \$1,000 wholesale value, \$500 of which value shall be in groceries and food staples.’
