**RESOLVE, Authorizing a Right of Way for a Pipeline over Land of State
School for Boys.**

State School for boys; authorizing a right of way for a pipeline over land.
Resolved: That the Commissioner of Institutional Service, in the name of the State of Maine be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey by quit claim deed to Portland Water District, its successors and assigns, the right perpetually to enter at any and all times upon a strip of land owned by the State of Maine and situated in the city of South Portland, in the county of Cumberland and State of Maine, said strip being shown on a plan entitled "Plan of Right of Way across land of State of Maine State School for Boys," dated December, 1956, said plan being now on file in the office of the Secretary of State, to which plan reference is hereby made for a more particular description of said strip, and to construct and perpetually maintain through and across said strip conduits or pipelines for conveying water and to lay, relay, repair, maintain and remove water pipe or pipes upon or under said strip with all necessary fixtures and appurtenances.
