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### **AN ACT** Relating to Membership of Certain Teachers in State Retirement System.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 63-A, § 3, sub-§ IX, additional.** Section 3 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes as enacted by section one of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered IX, to read as follows:

**IX.** Any teacher who first began to teach in the public schools of Maine prior to July 1, 1924 shall upon proper application, and verification of at least 15 years of such teaching service, be granted whatever retirement benefit may be developed on the basis of the total number of years of such service and the average compensation received during the 5 years during which the compensation was the highest.'
