### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Judge and Recorder of Lincoln Municipal Court, Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1913, c. 239, § 19, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 19 of chapter 239 of the private and special laws of 1913, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 14 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive the salary of \$2,000 \$2,500 per year, to be paid him in equal quarterly payments from the county treasury of Lincoln county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge, except as hereinbefore provided.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1913, c. 239, § 19, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 19 of chapter 239 of the private and special laws of 1913, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 14 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said salary shall not be paid until said judge shall have paid into the county treasury all fees so received by him. Said recorder shall receive a salary of \$1,500 \$1,800 per year.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1957.
