IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, To Construct Dormitory for Women at Gorham State Teachers College.

Dormitory for women; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$1,233,611 in favor of Gorham State Teachers College for construction of a Dormitory for women at Gorham State Teachers College; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Gorham State Teachers College is extremely overcrowded, with 281 women crowded into a dormitory built to house 217. Many applicants for admission have been refused because of lack of available housing facilities. This dormitory will provide for present enrollment and future expansion by the addition of housing space for 300 women and dining area for 400 students. Total floor area of this unit is 68,700 square feet.
