AN ACT Creating the Oak Grove Management Area.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 37, § 150-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 150-A, to read as follows :

'Game Management Areas.

Sec. 150-A. Game management areas. The following described territory shall be classified as a game management area to be managed by the Commissioner in accordance with the provisions of subsection VI of section 68 :

Oak Grove: The campus and land of Oak Grove School, in the town of Vassalboro, county of Kennebec, situated on the east side of route No. 100.'
