COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 256, L. D. 694, Bill, "An Act
to Authorize the State of Maine to Enter Into a
Compact with the States of Vermont and New Hampshire
to Establish a Tri-State Regional Medical Needs Board."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part of said Bill
designated as "Article II" the following underlined sentence 'The
chairman of the curriculum committee and the director of health
studies of the University of Vermont College of Medicine serve
without vote.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part of
said Bill designated as "Article IV" the following underlined
sentence 'Nothing above should be construed to interfere with the
sovereignty of the departments of health and welfare or the medical
societies of the individual compacting states.'

Reported by the Committee on Judiciary.
