STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Removal of Persons from Service in Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 32, repealed and replaced. Section 32 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 32. Removal from service. No person in the game warden service shall be dismissed or demoted except for such cause as would reduce the efficiency of the service.

The Commissioner shall present any charges for such dismissal or demotion to the Civil Service Commission created by section 27 who shall give to the person charged a written specification of such charges, a reasonable notice in writing of the time and place of hearing thereon, an impartial hearing, an adjudication on each charge and an adjudication of acquittal, of dismissal or demotion.

Copies of charges, notice of hearing, answer and adjudications by the Civil Service Commission shall be made a part of the records of the Department, and copies thereof shall be furnished to the person concerned if requested in writing.'
