### **AN ACT Relating to Sessions of Boards of Registration.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 3, § 16, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 16 of chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Open sessions shall be held for the purpose of registration and enrollment of voters from 9 to 12 o’clock in the morning, and from 2 to 5 o’clock in the afternoon, Saturday ~~afternoon~~ excepted.’
