## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 98th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 504, L. D. 714, Bill, "An Act Creating the Lake Christopher Game Management Area. Oxford County."

Amend said Bill by adding after the words "Oxford County" in the Title, the words 'and the Oak Grove Management Area, Kennebec County'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the 1st line, before the headnote, 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the single quotation mark at the end and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Oak Grove: The campus and land of Oak Grove School, in the town of Vassalboro, county of Kennebec, situated on the east side of route No. 100; and all the land of said School situated on the wide side of route No. 100."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. P. L., 1957, c. 74, repealed; limitation. Chapter 74 of the public laws of 1957, heretofore passed by this Legislature, amending chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby repealed and shall not be printed as part of the session laws of 1957.
