STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Penalties and Evidence Under Law Regulating Operation of Motor Vehicles for Profit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 48, § 32, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 32 of chapter 48 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'III. Any person employed as driver of any motor vehicle by any holder of a certificate or permit and any person who rides on any motor vehicle as employee of any such holder of a certificate or permit, and any person employed as driver of any motor vehicle or who rides on any motor vehicle as employee of any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of letting or leasing for hire, profit or compensation motor vehicles to be used by any other person, firm or corporation for the purpose of hauling or transporting goods, wares, merchandise or other property upon the public highways of this State for hire, shall be liable to the penalties provided in this section, in case said motor vehicle is operated in violation of the provisions of sections 19 to 32 33, inclusive, or of any rule, regulation or order issued by the Commission pursuant thereto.'
