STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Mary J. Libby of Presque Isle.

Mary J. Libby; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Mary J. Libby, of Presque Isle, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mary Libby is 90 years of age and lives with her son. The son is physically handicapped and due to illness in his family undergoes extreme hardship in supporting his mother. Mrs Libby has lived in this country since she was 13 years old but has never become a citizen so is not able to receive old age assistance.
