AN ACT Relating to Digging Clams in Kennebunkport, York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 57, amended. The 4th sentence of section 57 of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘From October 1, 1955 to October 1, ~~1957~~ 1959, no clams shall be dug or taken from the flats in Batson’s river or in any of its branches or tributaries, in said town of Kennebunkport, except that, during said 2-year period, any resident or property owner of said town may dig from said flats not to exceed 2 pecks of clams at one tide.’
