COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 486, L. D. 730, Bill, "An Act Imposing a Tax on Dry Beans."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the last 10 lines of "Sec. 288" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and punctuation:

'day of May of each year, render a report to the State Tax Assessor stating the quantity of dry beans received, sold or shipped by him during the preceding 12 calendar months on forms to be furnished by said Tax Assessor, and said report shall contain such further information pertinent thereto as said State Tax Assessor shall prescribe. At the same time as the filling of said report, each shipper shall pay to the State Tax Assessor a tax at the rate of 4¢ per bag upon all dry beans so reported as purchased, sold or shipped. The State Tax Assessor shall pay over all receipts from such tax to the Treasurer of State daily.'

Further amend said Bill in "Sec. 291" by adding after the underlined word "advertising" in the 2nd line of subsection II, the underlined punctuation and word ', merchandising'

Further amend said Bill in "Sec. 292" by adding after the underlined word "Commerce" in the 9th line, the underlined words 'and the Department of Agriculture!

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following section:

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective September 1, 1957.
