COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 273, L. D. 731, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Branding of Potatoes."

Amend said Bill in the 15th line by adding after the word
"grade" the underlined words and punctuation ', state or federal,'.

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting before the
period at the end thereof the following underlined words: ', or
if such potatoes fail to meet the minimum grade requirements
established as a state grade by the Commissioner of Agriculture'
