STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Brewer Band Parent Association.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves, unless emergencies, do not become effective until 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature; and

Whereas, the Brewer High School Band is to represent the State of Maine in the Cherry Blossom Festival in Washington, D. C. from April 1 to April 7, 1957; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that this resolve be passed immediately to aid in defraying the cost of such trip; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Brewer Band Parent Association; appropriation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to the Brewer Band Parent Association.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this appropriation is to aid in defraying cost of \$8,000 necessary to permit the Brewer High School Band to participate in the Cherry Blossom Festival in Washington, D. C.

The scheduled festivities are from April 1 to April 7 and as a part of the festivities the Brewer High School Band will represent the State of Maine and in their representation of the State give due credit to the educational and cultural accomplishments of our Maine educational system.
