IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Authority of Public Utilities Commission over Construction of Water Supply Systems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 44, § 13, repealed and replaced. Section 13 of chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 298 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 13. Commission to approve cost of construction of water system, method of financing and engineering standards. All municipalities, persons, corporations and water districts, before commencing construction of any new water system or any major addition to or alteration of an existing water system, shall file with the Commission, in accordance with rules and regulations to be issued by it, and to the extent required by such rules and regulations, plans and specifications for such construction, additions or alteration for the approval of the Commission as to cost, method of financing and adherence to proper engineering standards.'
