IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Declaring the Chinook the Official Dog of Maine.

Official dog of Maine; Chinook declared. Resolved: That the Chinook be, and hereby is, declared the official dog of Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State of Maine has never done honor to its canine friends by designating an official state dog. These loyal friends of Maine mean much to the peace, happiness and general comfort of the entire citizenry. The Chinook is a breed of world-wide renown and distinction.
