RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Education and Administration Building Fort Kent State Normal School.

Education and administration building; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$356,195 in favor of Fort Kent State Normal School to construct an education and administration building. Funds appropriated under the resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This building is a part of the State Board of Education's approved program for enlarging and improving the facilities of the school over a ten-year period. It would provide a two-story building to house classrooms, laboratories, library, and administrative offices. It is needed to replace the present obsolete, unsafe, and inadequate wooden frame building.
