**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Buxton for Aid Extended to
Irving and Rose Hodgdon.**

Town of Buxton; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$3,023.75 to be paid to the town of Buxton to reimburse it for aid given to Irving and Rose Hodgdon.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is an exceptional case not qualifying under the strict rules of the Department of Health and Welfare and the town should be reimbursed for this small percentage of the total money expended.
