IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Roads Intersected by a Controlled Access Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 8-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 8-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 8-A. Roads intersected by a controlled access highway. Whenever any road or street is intersected by any controlled access highway, it shall not be severed except by a vote of the municipality wherein the road or street is located. If said road is a county road, it shall not be severed except, in addition, by a vote of the county commissioners in said county after a public hearing.'
