STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Damage Claims on Controlled Access Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'Whenever any road is determined to be a controlled access road, the right of access shall be considered a separate item of damage and in the case of a new location of a controlled access road, the value of the right of access shall be determined by using the estimated traffic count or the actual traffic count the first year the road is open to traffic.'
