STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Access Connections on Controlled Access Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 8-B, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 8-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 8-B. Access connections on controlled access highways. Whenever a section of controlled access highway is planned by the Maine State Highway Commission, a public hearing shall be held in each muincipality affected to determine the adequacy of the access connections. Said public hearing shall be held before a joint board composed of one member of the State Highway Commission, a member of the board of county commissioners in the county involved, a member of the board of selectmen of a town or of the city council of a city in the municipality involved, the member of the Governer's Council from the district involved, and one member of the Public Utilities Commission. The decision of said board shall be final and binding on the State Highway Commission.'
