HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 541, L. D. 768, Resolve Relating to
Open Water Fishing Season in Certain Waters in Androscoggin
County

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title the following
Emergency Preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, the following legislation is
necessary in the best interests of conservation to protect the taking
of smelts; and

Whereas, resolves, unless passed as emergencies, do not become
effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature; and

Whereas, this legislation is necessary for conservation
reasons in the spring of 1957; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof the
following Emergency Clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
