IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Relating to Open Water Fishing Season in Certain Waters in Androscoggin County.

Certain waters in Androscoggin county; open to fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation extending to October 31st the fishing season in Androscoggin county for black bass, pickerel, perches, eels, hornpout and sunfish, except in the following bodies of water and their tributaries:

Auburn lake

Little Wilson pond

Pleasant pond, Turner

Thompson lake

Upper Range pond, Poland

Worthley pond, Poland
