AN ACT Providing for Short Form Record of Civil Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 107, amended. Section 107 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 107. Record of civil cases. After the rendition of final judgment or decree in any civil case at law or in equity, the clerk shall as soon as may be make such a record thereof ~~as the court by general rule or special order may direct~~ **in short form, except in such specific instances as the court by special order may direct.** If either party, however, files a request and tenders the fees therefor, a full, extended record shall be made. The Court may establish the form of such **short form record and** full, extended record.'
