STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Malt Liquor of Wholesale Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 20, amended. Section 20 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, as follows:

'No Maine wholesale licensee shall sell any malt liquor to a Maine retail malt liquor licensee in a quantity of less than $1\frac{1}{4}$ gallons if the delivery thereof is made by the wholesale licensee at a warehouse of the wholesale licensee, or in a quantity of less than 5 gallons if the delivery thereof is made by the wholesale licensee at any place other than a warehouse of the wholesale licensee.'
