IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of John F. Choate of Winslow.

John F. Choate; credits toward retirement. Resolved: That John F. Choate, of Winslow, be granted recognition for such period of time as he was in the employ of the Maine National Guard pursuant to section 90 of the National Defense Act of 1916 to entitle him to credit therefor toward retirement.
