RESOLVE, in Favor of George E. Baguall of Houlton.

George E. Baguall; credits toward retirement allowance. Resolved: That in arriving at the service retirement allowance payable to George E. Baguall, of Houlton, as the beneficiary nominated by Isaac Baguall, deceased member of the State Retirement System, credit be given for such period of time as the late Isaac Baguall was in the employ of the Maine National Guard pursuant to section 90 of the Defense Act of 1916.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Isaac Baguall, employed by National Guard, was a member of the State Retirement System. He should be given credit for this employment.
