STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Eliminate Inspection of Motorcycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 45, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 45 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Said inspection shall not apply to motor vehicles owned and registered in another state nor to new motor vehicles being driven by a dealer or his authorized representative from the point of distribution to his place of business. Said inspection shall not apply to motorcycles.'
