COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 559, L. D. 786, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Elections in Penobscot and Passamaquoddy
Tribes of Indians."

Amend said Bill in "Sec. 5" by striking out all of the 4th,
5th, 6th, 7th and 8th lines and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'years, on the 1st Tuesday of ~~October~~ November, the Passamaquoddy
tribe of Indians shall hold their election for the choice of
~~governers~~ governor and lieutenant ~~governers~~ governor of said
tribe, ~~and~~ a representative at the Legislature of this State,
all of whom shall alternate between the 2 reservations, and a
tribal committee to consist of 6 members of said tribe from each
reservation, all of whom must be at least 21 years of age.'
