AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Clerks of the Law Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 103, § 13, amended. The 1st sentence of section 13 of chapter 103 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall, from time to time, designate one or more of the clerks of court or some competent person or persons who shall act as clerks of the Law Court and receive such reasonable compensation as may be fixed by the Chief Justice, but which in the aggregate shall not exceed a total sum of ~~\$1,500~~ \$2,500 per year for all services rendered by such clerks including the issuing of certificates of rescripts.'
