STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Hydrologic Surveys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 44, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **'Sec. 10.** Authorized to confer with United States Geological Survey. The Commission may confer with the director or the representative of the United States Geological Survey and accepts its cooperation in the prosecution of hydrographic hydrologic and geological surveys, and the preparation of a contour topographic survey and map of the State.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958, and the sum of \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959, to carry out the purposes of this act.
