HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 297, L. D. 794, Bill, "An Act Relating to Board of Pupils Who Reside on a Coast Island Attending School Away From Home."

Amend said Bill in the Title thereof by striking out the words "Who Reside on a Coast Island"

Further amend said Bill by adding after "Sec. 1", a new section, as follows:

"Sec. 1-A. R. S., c. 41, §43, amended. The last sentence of section 43 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Commissioner is further authorized to make similar provisions for the transportation of any children who reside with a parent on state owned property located in towns of less than 100 inhabitants and-in-which-conveyance-fer-ne-ether-pupils-is-being-previded-by-the town.'"
