STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Display of Maine Alcoholic Beverage Products in State Liquor Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 55, amended. Section 55 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'Each state liquor store shall prominently display an exhibit of all alcoholic beverage products manufactured or bottled in this State, suitably marked by signs or placards to indicate that the same are Maine products.'
