RESOLVE, State Pension for Alec Reynolds, of Houlton.

Alec Reynolds; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Alec Reynolds, of Houlton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Reynolds is 65 years of age. Town of Houlton now giving and will continue to give rent for living quarters. The town authorities have a much more detailed statement of facts.
