IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Grace B. Veilleux of Biddeford.

Grace B. Veilleux; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Grace B. Veilleux, of Biddeford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Veilleux is 62 years of age. Her only support comes from a sister who is 69 years old and works in the Textile Mill in Saco. Miss Veilleux though not disabled has never worked in her life. The Department of Health and Welfare denied Aid to Disabled because medical review did not consider her sufficiently disabled.
