RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Elizabeth F. Courtois of Saco.

Elizabeth F. Courtois; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Elizabeth F. Courtois, of Saco, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Courtois is 87 years of age. She has the support of one daughter who also supports an older sister, who is unable to work. She also has one son who has a family of his own and is unable to provide any support. The Health and Welfare has disapproved the application for Old Age Assistance on grounds of the combined income of her son and daughter.
