AN ACT Relating to Citizens Committee on Survey of State Government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Citizens Committee on Survey of State Government. The Governor shall appoint such committees as may be necessary to co-operate in the further study of a general state survey, such committees to include members of the Legislature and representatives of the public generally ; such committees to continue further study as authorized by Chapter 169 of the Resolves of 1955.

Sec. 2. Expenses. The members of the committee shall be paid necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Any technical assistance to be employed shall be first approved by the Governor and Council.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$35,000 to carry out the purposes of this act and to pay for necessary office work, materials and necessary expenses of the committees. Such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1959.
