COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 325, L. D. 821, Bill, "An Act
Designating a Certain Road as "Mt. Katahdin Trail.""

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'"Mt. Katahdin Trail," designated. The following described highway is hereby designated as the "Mt. Katahdin Trail": Beginning in Newport at the junction of Route U.S. 2 and Route 7, extending to Dover Foxcroft over Route 7; thence to Milo by Route 16, to Millinocket by Route 11 and the Brownville-Millinocket road, so called; thence to Baxter State Park over the "Baxter State Park Road. Signs designating this as the "Mt. Katahdin Trail" shall be erected by the State Highway Commission at proper intervals along the highway.'

Reported by the Committee on Highways.

Read and adopted in the Senate March 12, 1957.
