

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Designating a Certain Road as "Moosehead Trail."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

"Moosehead Trail," designated. The following described highway is hereby designated as the "Moosehead Trail": Beginning in Newport at the junction of Routes No. 2 and No. 7 and extending to Dover-Foxcroft on Route No. 7, connecting with the presently designated "Moosehead Trail" beginning in Belfast and extending to Jackman over Routes No. 7 and No. 15.
