## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 98th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 330, L. D. 826, Bill, "An Act

Repealing Certain Provisions of Charter of the Town

of Bar Harbor."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

- 'Sec. 1. P. & S.L., 1949, c. 111, \$ 1, repealed and replaced. Section 1 of chapter 111 of the private and special laws of 1949, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 52 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'Sec. 1. Annual town meeting. The annual town meeting shall be held in the town of Bar Harbor, in the county of Mancock, on the 3rd Monday of March in each year, and the voters shall then choose by ballot, as now provided by law, a moderator to preside at said meeting, after which the polls shall be open for the balloting for town officers named in section 2.
- Sec. 2. P. & S.L., 1949, c. 111, \$\frac{1}{2}\$ 1-A and 1-B, repealed. Sections 1-A and 1-B of chapter 111 of the private and special laws of 1949, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 52 of the private and special laws of 1951, are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. Ratification. All acts of the municipal officers of the town of Bar Harbor on or since August 20, 1951, are hereby ratified.
