RESOLVE, in Favor of Harmon Rogers of Topsham.

Harmon Rogers; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$400 to be paid to Harmon Rogers, of Topsham, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damage done to his truck.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State Highway Commission crew in cutting bushes along side of the old road from Topsham to Pejepscot left a stump $1\frac{1}{2}$ ' high. Mr. Rogers, in plowing snow from the road, ran into the stump and damaged his truck.
