RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry K. Morey of Deer Isle.

Henry K. Morey; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to Henry K. Morey of Deer Isle, as a full and final settlement for claim against the State for damage done to his property because of construction on State road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State road forms the eastern boundary of the property of Mr. Morey and the buildings are set back 35 feet from the road. There is a 18' face cement curb, 160' long in front of the buildings, running parallel to the road; this curbing was placed there for the purpose of forming a gutter keeping waters running from the road away from Mr. Morey's yard. If the gutter has been kept clean this purpose would have been accomplished, but this has not been done, and consequently Mr. Morey's yard has water standing in it at all time. This has caused damage to his basement floors and caused the house to heave.
