HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 601, L. D. 848, Bill, "An Act Prohibiting Dogs Running at Large."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th lines of that part designated "Sec. 96-A" the following underlined words:

'Except that hunting dogs, commonly used for hunting purposes, may
be used for this purpose, during the period from February 1st to

March 31st, when accompanied by the owner or other authorized person.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 11th and 12th lines of that part designated "Sec. 96-A" the following underlined words:

'which fine and costs shall not be suspended.'
