IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Repealing Law on Inspection of Records of Clerks of Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 109, repealed. Section 109 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:

'See. 109. Examination and correction of records. The superior court shall cause the records of each clerk to be examined at least as often as there is a change of clerk, and when found deficient, direct them to be immediately made or corrected, and when such order is not obeyed, the fact of such deficiency shall be certified to the Treasurer of State, who shall cause the clerk's bond to be sued.'
