STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Common Carriers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 44, § 16, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 16 of chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'III. "Common carrier" includes every railroad company, street railroad company express company, dispatch, sleeping car, dining car, drawing-room car, freight line, refrigerator, oil, stock, fruit, car loaning, car renting, car loading and every other car corporation or person, their lessees, trustees, receivers, or trustees appointed by any court whatsoever, operating for compensation within this state; and every person, firm or corporation required to obtain a certificate of convenience and necessity under the provisions of chapter 48, every corporation or person their lessees, trustees, receivers or trustees appointed by any court whatsoever owning, controlling, operating or managing any vessel regularly engaged in the transportation of persons or property for compensation upon the waters of this State or upon the high seas, and their lessees, trustees or receivers appointed by any Court whatsoever, operating for compensation over regular routes between points within this State.'
