STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Arthur M. Clewley, of Etna.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Arthur M. Clewley; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Arthur Clewley, of Etna, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Clewley is 59 years of age. He was in the Fairfield Sanatorium from 1940-1943. He has one collapsed lung and 7 ribs removed. He now has a bad rupture and is unable to work. He weighs 115 pounds. He has no family.
